Oregonians who live in the Medford area and are worried about losing their home to foreclosure can find free help this Saturday.

People from state agencies, nonprofits and real estate groups will offer advice during a Home Ownership Preservation Event from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at the Higher Education Center at 101 South Bartlett in Medford.

Homeowners can set up a one-on-one meeting with a foreclosure counselor certified by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Both English- and Spanish-speaking counselors will be available.
