Earned Income Tax Credit Campaign – Funded by United Way of Columbia Willamette

All of the agencies listed here will provide free tax assistance and help in filing for EITC and Child Tax Credit from February 1st to April 15th.

What to bring with you:

Photo ID (required), Social Security Cards for you and your family, or a SSN/ITIN Verification letter (required), Birth dates for you, your spouse/registered domestic partner and dependents (required), Current year's tax

package (if you've received one), W-2 Form (from your jobs), 1099 (for per capita or misc income), Interest and dividend statements.

A copy of last year's federal and state returns if available, A voided check if using direct deposit for your refund, total paid for day care and day care provider's Tax ID Number, Student loan interest and tuition statements (for total money you spent on school).

For new home purchases, bring your closing statement (HUD-1), If filing joint tax returns electronically, both spouses/partners must be present to sign forms.
